Matthew 14:13–21 reveals a Lord who meets human hunger with divine compassion, turning scarcity into abundance through the generosity of a single offering. Jesus does not simply feed a crowd; He teaches us that when we place even our small, imperfect gifts in His hands, He multiplies them beyond anything we could imagine. This miracle reminds us that God's grace is never limited, and that our willingness to share—however little we think we have—becomes the place where His love overflows for others.
