






# **MEETING JESUS IN THE MASS** — Week 6 VI. The Liturgy of the Eucharist, Part C

Reflecting on the Communion Rite, ask yourself and the Lord these questions:

- What does it mean to me and my life that I receive the Real Presence of Jesus Christ when I receive Holy Communion? Am I growing in wonder and awe of the Lord?
- In receiving Holy Communion, I am brought into deeper union with Jesus Christ and with all who have ever been and will ever be in union with Him. How does knowing this change my appreciation of the Eucharist and my relationship to others?
- Has the Eucharist renewed and strengthened me in the life of Jesus and my resolve to bring this life to the poor?
- How is my encounter with Jesus in Holy Communion a transformative encounter with the Kerygma (see page 5 for a description of the Kerygma)?

#### **Lenten Fast & Abstinence Requirements**

Ash Wednesday, Feb 14, and Good Friday, March 29, are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Personal health issues should be taken into account.
